### **Admissions Policies**

- Payments must be made at the Ticket Booth in <u>one lump sum</u> on the day of your visit.
- Refunds are given by check only and are mailed after your visit.
- Purchase orders are not accepted.
- Groups will not be invoiced, all payments are processed prior to zoo entry on trip day.
- Adults visiting with your group but not included on the group order can purchase individual tickets for \$22 on Trip Day at the the Ticket Booth. Sibling Prices are \$14.
- Knox County Schools Receive Free Admission.
- Popular dates are capped and do fill up, don't wait to complete reservation!

### **Additional Info**

- Tent Reservations, Education Programs, Rides, and Experiences are all additionalto Admission Fees. All items are by reservation only and purchased together with one payment method at check in on trip day.
- Use separate reservation forms for separates dates/multiple visits.
- Cancellations and changes for any reason, including inclement weather, please email or call to reschedule.
- At least 1 chaperone or teacher must remain with each group of 10 students, regardless of age.
- Federal Title 1 Students receive an admission fee reduction allowance tovisit Zoo Knoxville by submitting the School Group Admission Fee ReductionForm a minimum of 3 weeks in advance.
- Attendance numbers can be altered at check-in to accommodate small changes.

Education Department Staff will contact you to schedule your program time and send a invoice by e-mail for your learning program. Payment will be collected at the Ticket Boo for all field trip activities and admission in one lump sum before you enter the Zoo Knoxville. Please bring a check made out to Zoo Knoxville. We cannot offer refunds after payment is received unless a program is cancelled by Zoo Knoxville. If you decide to cancel your program for any reason, please contact the education program as soon Knoxville does not bill or accept purchase orders.

## FIELD TRIP FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### What's Next?

Once Reservation Forms are processed, you will receive a confirmation email with trip information.

#### Additional Parents Or Siblings

As the group leader, it is your choice to include additional adults(over the included 1 free per 10 students) and siblings on your order for \$20/\$14. They may use their membership or purchase tickets at the Ticket Booth on trip day for \$22/\$14 by telling the booth they are part of your group.

#### Students With A Membership

Students may be included on a Family Membership, in which case the card (or a photo copy) should be presented at the Ticket Scanner during the entry. Teachers/students may carry/present the pass.

#### Payments

Payments for group activities(admission, experiences, and education programs) are due in one lump sum at check-in at the Ticket Booth. Guest counts are updated upon arrival. Checks can be made out to Zoo Knoxville.

#### Lunch Time/ Tent Reservations

Groups may bring in their own lunches/ coolers to picnic in one of the first come first serve lunch spaces. Coolers can be stored at the Stroller Booth by the Zoo Entrance, groups are responsible for transporting their own lunches throughout the zoo. Event Tent Reserved Seating is available on select weekdays for \$3 per seat for a 45min lunch period starting at 10a, 11a, or 12p. Cooler Transport is included with Tent Reservations. Do not pack drinks with disposable lids/ straws(juice boxes/pouches), straws are dangerous to our animals and prohibited on Zoo Knoxville grounds.

#### Parking

Parents/chaperones should park in the lower parking lot upon arrival and walk to meet their bus at the Zoo Entrance. Groups check in at the Ticket Booth and pay \$5 parking fee per vehicle. Busses and large vans do not pay for parking, but should follow parking instructions to the Chilhowee Pond.

#### Seasonal Suggestions

As a mostly outdoor experience, check the weather and have all student dress accordingly for rain, wind, and temperature swings. Ponchos can be purchased in the Zoo Shop. Water bottles are encouraged.

#### **Spending Money**

Spending Money isn't a necessity to have fun at Zoo Knoxville, but is helpful for individual interests. Seasonally available Animal Encounters are \$2-\$5. Children's Train and Carousel Rides are \$4 per rider while Soaring Eagle Zipline Rides for those 47in+ tall are \$13. Rides are weather dependent and may close without notice. Pepsi Drink Machines offer \$3 items. A variety of Zoo Shop Souvenirs are available for \$10-\$20. Eateries throughout the park offer snacks and treats for \$10 and meals for \$15.

#### Entry & Exit Process

Busses arrive to Front Gate, Contact Teacher checks in at Ticket Booth while students unload withZoo Staff to side gates. Contact Teacher distributes tickets to chaperones included on group order. All admission tickets are scanned during entry. Parents enter via main gate and reunite with studentsin the main plaza. Signing out students and passing out lunches must happen inside the Zoo Gates. To Exit, Groups will gather in main entry plaza. Allow at least 20min to load and exit. Zoo Staff willverify with Contact Teacher all guests are accounted for, Zoo Staff will release busses to leave the Parking Lot, pull to the roundabout and collect students. \*Busses cannot wait for groups in roundabout due to fire lane restrictions.\*

#### Groups Without Busses

Groups without busses gather by the Zoo Shop Exit, entrance gates and windows must remain clear.
